WHAT'S NEW?

The School District of Ladysmith, Bray Architects, Kraus-Anderson, and our consultants have been busy confirming that the scope of work aligns with the referendum budget. Also, on August 17, Bray Architects presented the new secure entry plan to the School Board. The new secured entry will limit the public's access through secured vestibule doors into the Main Lobby during school hours. The secure access points will also vary by event type for the various school and community events held outside of school hours.

PLANNING & DESIGN UPDATE

Bray Architects presented the concept design for the Media Center to the district. The concept centers around the "North Woods" with features including a flexible reading area with exterior views of the woods beyond, high clearstory windows for increased natural light with large roof overhangs to decrease glare, the use of natural wood in the interior, and exposed wood beam structure.

Bray also presented flooring options to replace the current hallway carpeting. The presented flooring examples ranged in price, maintenance requirements, and color options. Bray and Kraus-Anderson will continue working with the district to choose a flooring material that meets both budget requirements and maintenance needs.

The civil engineer team is exploring options to improve the football field's drainage. Design and improvement discussions for outdoor athletics also include new bleachers, a press box, and replacing the dugouts at the softball fields.
